Official Rules and Information

TOURNAMENT DATE: Saturday, June 21, 2008

ENTRY FEE: \$200 per boat postmarked through June 7th; \$225 thereafter. Entry includes two (2) tickets to the awards dinner; One (1) Captain's meeting dinner ticket; Tournament Bucket with T-Shirt (1). First 50 entries get One (1) Official Embroidered Tournament Captains Bag.

TOTAL ANGLERS: Maximum number of anglers is 6 per boat with no more than 6 lines in the water.

CAPTAIN'S MEETING: Sugar Cane Island Bistro, Friday June 20, 6:00 pm. The captain or a representative angler from each boat entered MUST attend this meeting. Food and beverages will be available.

HOURS OF FISHING: Lines in at 6:30 am and out at 3:00 pm.

RADIO: The tournament committee will monitor Channel 72 during tournament hours.

WEIGH-IN: Weigh Stations open at 1:00 pm. All fish weighed must be brought to either Blowing Rocks Marina weigh station or Riviera Beach Municipal Marina by boat no later than 4:30 pm and must be weighed in the presence of the weigh master. The angler or captain and the weight will be recorded on an official weigh-in form dated and signed by the angler or captain and the weigh master. No transferring fish between boats. All fish weighed will become property of The Jupiter Inlet Offshore Fishing Club. Anglers will receive one (1) raffle ticket for each eligible fish weighed or donated to the Club. All donated fish will be sold to benefit the Riviera Beach Maritime Academy and our Marine Environment.

TIES: Should a tie occur, the winner will be determined by the earliest weigh-in-time.

PROTESTS: Official protests must be presented in writing to the weigh master by 4:30 pm for distribution to the Tournament Committee. Decisions by the Tournament Committee are final.

ELIGIBLE FISH: King Mackerel, Dolphin, Wahoo, and Bonito. All State & Federal Rules governing weight, size and limit must be observed. Fishing license is required and will be checked at the weigh station.

RULES: Electric reels are NOT permitted on any boat. Fish must be caught within 25 nautical miles of the Jupiter Inlet or Lake Worth Inlet. NO Bahamas fishing! Both Live, Dead and Artificial baits can be used.

AWARDS ELIGIBILITY:(Based initially on 100 boats and subject to change) The Grand Prize for Heaviest Bull and Cow Dolphin Combined (\$2,000, \$1,000, \$500); Largest Dolphin Overall (\$1,000); Wahoo (\$2,000, \$1,000, \$500); Kingfish (\$2,000, \$1,000, \$500), will be awarded to the boat weighing in the heaviest eligible fish. Additional prize goes to largest Bonitos (\$1,000, \$500, \$250). Calcutta (optional, \$100 per boat) is \$3,000 for heaviest overall eligible fish. Each boat is eligible to win either first, second, or third place for each species. No one boat can win more than 1 prize in each species category. Special J&R Custom Rod fitted and made to order will be awarded to the Junior angler, and Lady angler with one of the heaviest eligible fish. All Cash and Prizes will be awarded to the person or entity that paid the entry fee for the winning boat.

AWARDS BANQUET: Held at Sugar Cane Island Bistro, June 21st, starting at 5:00 pm with live entertainment and Cocktails outside at the Sugar Cane Tike Bar; At 6:30 pm Dinner then Awards presentation follows with Dancing and fun lasting until you drop. Awards banquet dinner tickets will be available at the door.

WEATHER: The decision to fish is solely the captain's choice. All anglers fish at their own discretion and risk. If the tournament committee determines it is unsafe to fish, all cash awards will be presented by randomly selecting boat names at the awards banquet (must be present to win). No entry refunds or rain checks.

RELEASE: By signing the entry form, the angler agrees to follow the tournament rules and that the tournament and/or it's sponsors may use without payment or restriction any photographs in which he or she appears for any purpose whatsoever but not limited to resale, advertising, commercial or promotional material. All anglers are required to sign their entry blank form as certification that they read and agreed to abide by all rules and the above liability release.
